Batting Points 1 point per run

Bowling Points 25 points per wicket

Additional Points Additional bonus points can be gained only under the following circumstances:

1 The team batting first is dismissed for a score less than 120 runs in their 40 over innings (or in a reduced overs match, less than 3 runs per over)

and;

2 The team batting second wins the game by 6 wickets or better. (i.e. Victory is achieved for the loss of 4 or less wickets.)

Should the team batting first not be dismissed before the end of their innings, no additional bonus points are available to the team batting second.

In the circumstances detailed above, the following shall apply:

For each ball not delivered to the team batting first, 1 bonus point will be awarded to the team batting second.

Example 1: Team batting first is dismissed for 80 runs in 25.2 overs in a 40 over match. Team batting second wins the game by scoring 81 runs in 30 overs for the loss of 4 wickets.

14 overs and 4 balls have not been bowled to the team batting first, a total of 88 balls. 88 points will be awarded to the team batting second.

Example 2: Team batting first is dismissed for 75 runs in 25 overs in a 30 over match. (less than 90 runs / 3 runs per over.) Team batting second wins the game by scoring 76 runs in 20 overs for the loss of 3 wickets.

5 overs have not been bowled to the team batting first, a total of 30 balls. 30 points will be awarded to the team batting second.
